SYNOPSIS

One day, LEV, a mysterious man hiding his true identity as a Russian Mafia interrogator, returns to his childhood country, India, to visit his non-biological brother and his brother's two-year-old daughter. Upon arrival, he discovers that his family has been murdered, leaving only LEELA, alive. LEV is entrusted with raising her and avenging their deaths. As he hunts down the killers, he uncovers a web of conspirators, ultimately choosing to forgive them and protect LEELA instead. Each year, LEV returns to his family's grave with LEELA, who grows up believing LEV is her real father.

Like every year, LEV returns to the city with his now-grown daughter, LEELA, and crosses paths with MIRA, a determined lady detective and the daughter of a high-ranking police officer who had close ties to LEV's deceased brother. MIRA is investigating a murder case linked to a dangerous criminal network involved in illegal drug operations. The criminals, eager to stop the investigation, attempt to kill MIRA several times, but LEV secretly saves her life each time, never revealing his true identity.

As MIRA closes in on the truth, she discovers a deeper conspiracy, with the mastermind targeting her family—and LEELA. In a brutal act of revenge, LEV eliminates the criminals and uncovers that they were responsible for his brother's death and the threat to his newfound family—MIRA and LEELA. Witnessing LEV's actions, MIRA realizes his motivations are rooted in justice, not evil. She falls in love with him and, ultimately, decides to stay with LEV and LEELA, becoming the mother LEELA never had. Unaware of her true origins, LEELA grows up loving LEV and MIRA as her real parents.

TREATMENT

1. PLOT SUMMARY:

- The Murder and Discovery

In a moment of frustration, MONOHAR, an enforcer for the ruthless drug lord RUDRA, murders the Bureau Director's troubled, drug-addicted son who often begged him for drugs. To cover his tracks, MONOHAR dumps the body in a remote lake. When the body is discovered, police officer NILANJON connects the murder to an old unresolved case involving MONOHAR.

- The Investigation Begins

NILANJON convinces the detective, MIRA, to reach out to LEV, who is visiting the city for his brother's death anniversary. NILANJON insists that MIRA gather any information from LEV that might link MONOHAR to the murder. MIRA reluctantly agrees and waits for LEV's arrival. Meanwhile, MIRA, through a stroke of luck, uncovers a lead that might connect MONOHAR to the crime. She teams up with detective MR. BOSE and MR. GUPTA investigates, but they are ambushed and kidnapped by MONOHAR's gang.

- LEV's Arrival and Discovery

The next day, LEV arrives, and NILANJON takes him to the police station. News of a car accident involving AMARTYA and another officer, SANDEEP, worries LEV, as he recognizes them from a past incident. LEV and NILANJON rush to the hospital, where they discover that MIRA is AMARTYA's daughter. Realizing MIRA has been kidnapped by the gangsters, LEV decides to rescue her and embarks on a mission to save her life.

- The Rescue and MONOHAR's Betrayal

After LEV successfully rescues MIRA, they gather crucial evidence against MONOHAR. Fearing exposure, MONOHAR goes to his boss, RUDRA, to seek protection. However, RUDRA realizes that if MONOHAR is caught, he could reveal vital information that would destroy RUDRA's entire drug empire. 1. Primary Characters:

LEV SEN, 34, a master of darkness, calm and emotionless face, speaks firm & straightforwardly with a fearless deep voice, valuing time as precious; don't be afraid of his attitude—beneath it lies a loving and caring father, especially with his daughter. He can, however, discharge his rage if triggered.

LEELA SEN, 6, with long hair and boundless energy. She cares for her father, and her gentle, clear voice makes her lovable to everyone. Despite her bright demeanor, she hides a sad side within.

MIRA SEN (Known as MISS SEN), 29 - A beautiful, intelligent, and a lead bureau investigator. Serious and always immersed in work, she has no time for family. Though she seems cold, she hides a loving side from everyone.

2. Secondary Characters:

AMARTYA SEN, 66, a retired police officer with salt-and-pepper hair, always dressed in khadi. He's a responsible, grounded father, simple & loving.

SANDEEP ROY, 32, a Sub-Inspector, lives with AMARTYA and often acts as a cook. Dressed in checked formal attire, he's adaptable, childlike in his maturity, yet deeply loving and respectful.

GANGSTER, 31, carries a threatening aura. He wears a messy, textured design shirt with formal trousers, a loose chain bracelet resting on his wrist. Though he makes others afraid, he himself is scared of dangerous people like LEV.

THE UNDER-BOSS, 30, the GANGSTER'S trusted second, always wears a black-and-white zebra-print shirt with black trousers. He talks big about being an expert killer and always carries a DULL foldable knife. Beneath his tough talk, he's quick to panic, often running from danger with a fake crying face.

RUDRA CHATTERJEE, 35, behind his gentle exterior lies a cunning and evil mentality. He has no respect for anyone and masks his true nature by presenting himself with a tough, commanding temper. He firmly believes he is the most powerful person and speaks fearlessly, unafraid to challenge or intimidate others.

THE SHADOW, 34, a silent and lethal right-hand to RUDRA CHATTERJEE, *THE SHADOW* is a masked enigma who works in the background, executing orders with RUTHLESS precision. Dressed in black formal attire with a golden cross pendant symbolizing Jesus, his calm demeanor hides his deadly nature.

MONOHAR GANGULY, 40, a slightly overweight notorious drug mafia and well-connected business man wears a thick golden chain. A snake tattoo glides down his left arm. Though he appears cool and collected, he has a short temper and may kill anyone without hesitation.

NILANJAN MITRA, 35, POLICE SUB-INSPECTOR. Beneath his normal appearance lies a sharp, clever officer, always carrying an air of suspicion, seeing everything through a lens of conspiracy.

ABHIJIT BHADURI, 37, ASSISTANT SUB-INSPECTOR slightly overweight with a rounded belly. He always carries an inhaler for his asthma. Respectful to all, but don't be fooled—he turns corrupt when night falls.

3. Minor Characters:

THE RICH BOY, 23, in casual clothes, don't be fooled by his gentle appearance—he is actually addicted to drugs and alcohol, the typical troubled son of a wealthy father.

The THIEF, 31, is a short man with messy, long hair. He always carries a sack and owns a cyber café. Though born into a life of stealing, he strongly denies it to everyone. A master of deception, he can instantly switch from casual chatter to a serious, commanding tone.

MR. GUPTA, 34, a bureau investigator who always wears formal attire. Serious and calm, he relies on other detectives for decisions. He has a casual relationship with Mr. Bose, and often stops Mr. Bose for preventing the extra talk

MR. BOSE, 33, a bureau investigator who always wears formal attire and black-framed glasses. Though he appears brave, his expression turns childlike and fearful in dangerous situations.

BUREAU DIRECTOR, 60, a professional in a navy blue suit and boxy-framed eyeglasses. His white hair adds to his serious presence. Though he hides his emotions, they show subtly through his actions.

THE DRIVER, 50, is a mountain-born man with small, sharp eyes, always in a proper driving uniform, simple and loving.

MAID, 45, the DRIVER'S wife, dressed in traditional hilly attire, with small, kind eyes, lovingly cares for LEEEA.

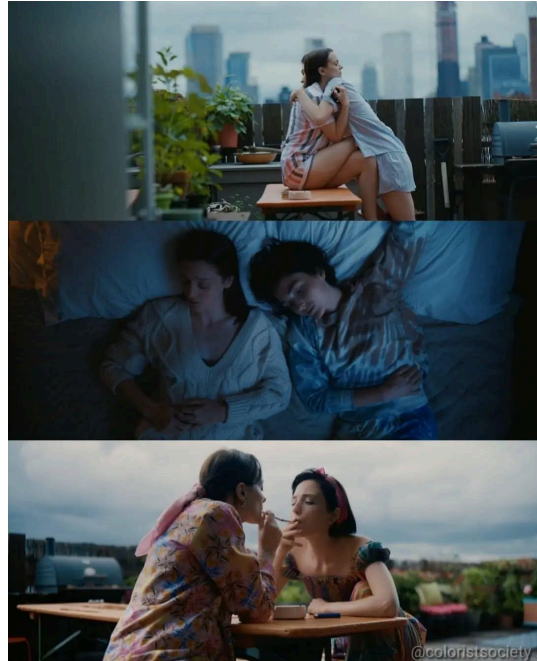
BODYGUARDS & GANG-MEMBERS, 30-35, professional and composed, dressed in formal attire, they maintain order with precision and authority.
